Are young children in Snohomish County ready for kindergarten when they enter?




Only 47% of children in Snohomish County demonstrate characteristics of entering kindergartners in 6 of 6 domains. ²

Child care supply in Snohomish County



In Snohomish County, the number of child care providers has dropped from 683 with capacity for 16,754 children in 2012, to 525 providers with capacity for 16,738 children in December 2016.*
