News from Child Care Aware of WA Scholarships

It's celebration time! We are celebrating all of our graduates who have inspired us with their hard work, determination and dedication to helping Washington's children and families. Congratulations to everyone graduating this year!

Child Care Aware of Washington also is celebrating 30 years as our state's most trusted child care resource. Thank you to all of our wonderful partners who have helped us reach this

milestone. We can't wait to see what the next 30 years hold for all of us.

Did you know that CCA of WA Scholarships can provide scholarships to providers who want to meet the updated minimum education WAC requirement? Providers have five years from Aug. 1, 2019 to meet the requirement. Our scholarships for child care professionals who want to earn a bachelor's degree in ECE cover up to \$9,000 in tuition and fees, book reimbursement up to \$500 and up to three hours per week of release time paid to the employer at a rate of \$11 per hour. We also provide a completion incentive for scholars who have successfully completed their scholarship contracts.

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Summer Reminders:

Scholarship Waitlist

CCA of WA Scholarships currently has a waitlist, which means we've reached the maximum number of scholarships that can be awarded at this time.

In order to renew your scholarship, active scholars must be in good standing at the time we review for new awards. This means submitting all required paperwork, including transcripts with grades and academic advising forms. Additionally, scholars must successfully complete the minimum number of credits specified in their current scholarship contract.

Renewals are not guaranteed and are based on a scholar's standing and available funding.
